COVID-19 Health & Safety Protocols

In light of COVID-19, our team has been working around the clock to implement additional procedures and protocols to ensure a socially responsible environment that aligns with our core values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility.

Enhanced Cleaning & Disinfecting

We have implemented the latest cleaning protocols from the CDC. Our maintenance staff is on top of sanitizing all areas of KleinLife, especially shared spaces.

Social Distancing

We've reconfigured spaces to allow for social distancing and added signage throughout our facility to direct the flow of traffic. You'll find our fitness equipment spaced out and markers on the floor to make social distancing as easy as possible.

Sanitation Stations

Additional hand sanitizing stations are available throughout our facility.

Masks

Masks or face shields are required at all times in our facilities. This includes indoor group exercise classes, cardio and strength workouts and at all transitional spaces within the facility. Masks or face shields will not be required while in the pool swimming or while showering.

Health Checks

All staff, members and guests will review several health screening questions prior to entering the facility and will be temperature-screened. Anyone showing signs of COVID-19 or who has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, will not be permitted to enter for the safety of all members.

Single Entry/Exit Points

To maintain our safety protocols, KleinLife will maintain a single entry and single exit point. This point is the rear parking lot main entrance/exit.

Amenity Availability

To protect your health and safety, some amenities are not open. As soon as we are confident that we can open these areas safely, we will.

Contactless Check In/Out

As always, all are required to check in at the front desk to access the facility. Plexiglass shields have been installed so that you are able to safely talk with staff.

Water Fountains

To protect everyone's health, water fountains are not available. However, water jugs are so be sure to bring a water bottle with you.
