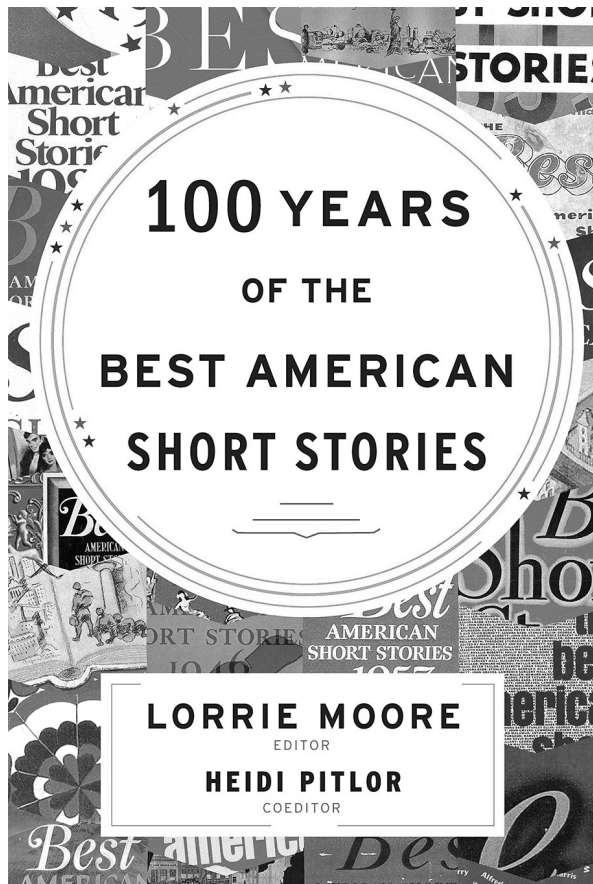


100 Years of the Best American Short Stories
